

**2022 Camp Gesher COVID Community Contract:
For everyone entering Camp Gesher**

Updated June 2022

Carefully review and sign this COVID Community Contract. Together we can create a magical and meaningful camp experience AND prevent and manage COVID as well as possible. You are our partners in this work. Please acknowledge and reflect on your personal responsibility as part of our camp community.

During the 7 days prior to my arrival at Camp Gesher, I will wear a high filtration mask (N95/KN95/KN94-level) when indoors in public or crowded spaces (including day camps, summer school, during travel).

If I have a known exposure to a confirmed COVID case during the 7 days prior to my arrival at Camp Gesher, I will contact the camp to make individual arrangements.

If I am traveling by airplane or public transportation during the 7 days prior to my arrival, I will use caution when traveling through airports and stations and I will wear a high filtration mask (N95/KN95/KN94-level) and maintain physical distance (to the best of my ability) and diligent hand hygiene.

If I develop COVID symptoms during the 7 days prior to my arrival at Camp Gesher, I will conduct rapid antigen COVID testing on 2 consecutive symptomatic days to rule out COVID infection.

Prior to my arrival at Camp Gesher, I will take a PCR test before traveling to camp. If the test result is positive for COVID, I will contact camp to make individual arrangements for a delayed arrival.

During my time at Camp Gesher, I will communicate to camp staff *immediately* if I develop any COVID symptoms.

In the case of my testing COVID positive during my time at Camp Gesher, I have prepared a plan for isolating at home (or somewhere else off campus with a parent/guardian) including being picked up within 7 hours of calling my parent/guardian. If for any reason my parent/guardian can not pick me up, here are two additional emergency contacts who will be able to pick me up from camp:

Our protocols and guidelines will always be subject to change based on the latest guidelines from health experts and authorities, and provincial and local protocols. We will continue to communicate openly and frequently about these plans and we are grateful for your partnership with us in this work.
